President Doug Ramsey called the meeting to order with a devotion and lead prayer.

Motion by Guy Kerley; seconded by Dennis Rhyne to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on October 20, 2020. Motion carries.

#### PASTORS REPORTS:

The pastors offered their thanks for the monetary gift that was given to them for Pastor Appreciation month in October. They have moved into their new rental home and will be taking a vacation in mid-November to see their son in Connecticut. They are working to get communion to the home bound. The list of home bound has increased due to the virus. Plans ae being made to have 3 services on Christmas Eve. Hopefully, there will be a service for everyone.
