### "I love to tell the story of Jesus and his love."

One of the greatest joys of my short time with you has been listening to stories. Stories of the history of Friendship Lutheran dating back to the old building when men and women entered through different doors of the church building, which was warmed by a wood burning stove. Stories of the ways you are connected to one another. Stories of how traditions, like the friendship community meal, got started as a fish fry. Stories of an old 15 passenger van that got kids to camp and adults to concerts. Stories of loved ones who have since passed on. In turn you have heard more of my story, in opening introductions and sermon stories. We learn so much and build such trust by listening to one another's stories.

As part of learning the congregation's story, I've also read a summary of the listening posts that happened last summer. We can certainly learn from conversations with people for whom the church is important. In that spirit, Doug Ramsey, council chair, has organized a council retreat to look at the summary of the listening posts. Later in March, the council will go to Lutheridge for an overnight retreat with Pastor Gary Haddock, who is from the Center for Congregational Health and who facilitated the listening posts. As a tool to look forward, the council will glean what is important to the congregation and how we can live together in healthy ways.

Our Lenten journey continues throughout this entire month, by gathering on Sunday evenings to hear Pastor Mary tell a story and hear stories from the bible to which we can connect our stories. Our Lenten pilgrimage will soon reach the Holiest of Weeks when we will enter into the story of Jesus Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem and a last supper with his disciples and the pain of Good Friday. It's a formative story for our faith as it reveals God's nature and might on a cross and in an empty tomb. I look forward to more listening and sharing of stories. And I look forward hearing how God's story in scripture can speak to each of our stories as well as the continuing story of Friendship Lutheran Church.

President Doug Ramsey called the meeting to order and shared a devotion.
